12-Month Member Survey

A committee in our congregation participated in the FAN Online Training about a year ago! Some members of our congregation also took part in online member survey to help understand the impact of FAN in our church. It is time for the follow-up member survey. The purpose of this survey is to understand the impact of FAN from church members' perspective. The survey is NOT designed to evaluate our church, but rather, to evaluate the FAN program. The survey is confidential. The FAN 12-Month Church Member Survey is being done by the University of South Carolina Prevention Research Center as part of a research study.

What will you be asked to do?

If you completed an online survey about a year ago as part of the FAN evaluation, it is almost time for you to complete your follow-up member survey. In early May, the FAN staff will email you your personal link to complete your confidential survey. The survey will take about 15 minutes and will include questions about physical activity, healthy eating, and church practices. These surveys will begin on 05/02/2022. We encourage everyone who receives a link to the survey to complete it as soon as possible. These surveys must be completed by 05/31/2022.

What are the benefits?

If you participate and complete your follow-up member survey, you receive a small thank you gift and will be entered in a drawing for a \$50 gift card. In addition, if our church reaches our target goal for member survey participation, our church will receive a financial reward.
