We are in the process of establishing Class Leaders within our church. Over the past several weeks, selected leaders have been identified and contacted regarding this opportunity.

If you have not been contacted but believe that serving as a Class Leader aligns with your spiritual gifts, please reach out to Debbie Sanders.

Below is an overview of key responsibilities and expectations. Please note that this list is not exhaustive, and additional duties may be assigned. A training session is currently being planned for all Class Leaders.

Roles and Responsibilities:

Spiritual Oversight & Nurture

Provide care for the spiritual well-being of class members through prayer, encouragement, and regular check-ins.

Communication Bridge

Serve as a vital link between the pastor and church members by sharing important updates and informing the pastor of members who are sick or in need.

Accountability & Care

Maintain consistent contact with assigned members to offer support and ensure they remain connected to the church community.

Pastoral Support

Assist the pastor by visiting the sick and bereaved, and by identifying members who may be in need of additional care or who have become disconnected from the church.

Organization of Classes

- Each class will have two Co-Leaders (one leader may be approved by the pastor if necessary).
- Class Leaders will serve under the direction of the Pastor and the Lay Leader
